

ORAL CANCER CHECK-UP CAMP 2022 - PRESENT

What is the project about?

In the Bhaskar Nagar community, over 90% of the male population consumes tobacco in different forms (smoked, chewed, snuff dipped, etc.). As tobacco use significantly increases the risk of cancer, a camp was organised for screening and early detection of oral cancer. Any cases that require further investigation are referred to Shivaji Hospital and TATA Memorial Hospital.

Where is the project?

The project is in Shravan Medical Center, Bhaskar Nagar, Kalwa, Mumbai.

Who is targeted by the project?

Those targeted by the project include the participating women from the Healthy Homes project, their male family members, as well as men from the community of Bhaskar Nagar. The project has reached 204 people as of March 2023.

What are the goals of the project?

The goals include:

- ✓ Oral screening, early detection of oral cancer, referrals to IDA for biopsy, as well as referrals to Shivaji and TATA Hospitals for further investigation and treatment.
- ✓ Visits from Humble Smile community health workers to homes in the community to promote health, explain the camp, motivate individuals (especially men) to join, and follow up on cases.

How is the progress of the project?

The camp was conducted 4 times in 2022:
